**AMENDMENT**  
**OFFERED BY MR. BURGESS OF TEXAS**  
**(to the text of H.R. 3962)**

Section 1701(e) of title VII of division B is amended  
to read as follows:

1       (e) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—

2           (1) **IN GENERAL.**—The amendments made by  
3       this section shall take effect in a State on the first  
4       day of the first year after the certification described  
5       in paragraph (2) is made by the State to the Sec-  
6       retary.

7           (2) **CERTIFICATION.**—A certification described  
8       in this paragraph is a certification, in such form and  
9       manner as may be prescribed by the Secretary, made  
10       by each State that—

11           (A) certifies that there is an adequate level  
12       of access to pediatricians, pediatric specialists  
13       (including pediatric mental health specialists),  
14       and pediatric sub-specialists for targeted low-in-  
15       come children covered under the State plan;  
16       and

17           (B) includes the results of a survey, that  
18       may be conducted by the American Academy of

1           Pediatrics, a State professional medical society,  
2           or other qualified organization, that establishes  
3           that such an adequate level exists on a per child  
4           basis.
