**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3962****OFFERED BY MR. DEAL OF GEORGIA, MR. HELL-  
ER OF NEVADA, MR. WILSON OF SOUTH  
CAROLINA, AND MR. SAM JOHNSON OF TEXAS****(Amendment to H.R. 3962, As Posted on the Rules Committee  
Website)**

In section 342(a)(1), strike “lawfully present in a State in the United States (other than as a non-immigrant described in a subparagraph (excluding subparagraphs (K), (T), (U), and (V)) of section 101(a)(15) of the Immigration and Nationality Act)” and insert “a citizen or national of the United States or an alien who is not ineligible for medical assistance under Medicaid under title IV of the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996, is present in a State in the United States, and”.

In section 341(b), strike paragraphs (4) through (6) and insert the following:

- 1           (4) VERIFICATION OF CITIZENSHIP OR ALIEN
- 2           QUALIFICATION.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 3           sion of law, only citizens and nationals of the United
- 4           States and aliens described in paragraph (1) shall be
- 5           eligible for affordability credits under this subtitle.

1 The Commissioner shall require any individual who  
2 receives an affordability credit under this title to  
3 provide (within 60 days of the date of receiving such  
4 affordability credit) satisfactory documentation of  
5 such citizenship or nationality in a manner con-  
6 sistent with section 1903(x) of the Social Security  
7 Act or such alienage in a manner consistent with the  
8 requirements of section 1137(d) of such Act (in the  
9 same manner as such section applies to States). The  
10 Commissioner shall keep sufficient records such that  
11 a determination of citizenship, nationality, or  
12 alienage only has to be made once for any individual.  
13 The Commissioner shall fully reimburse the United  
14 States Treasury, from funds appropriated to carry  
15 out this subtitle, within 60 days for any funds  
16 outlayed to or on behalf of any individual is found  
17 to not be such a citizen, national, or qualifying alien.

18 (5) REQUIREMENT FOR PRESENTATION OF  
19 IDENTITY DOCUMENT.—Section 1902(ee)(1)(A) of  
20 the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395b(ee)(1)(A))  
21 is amended—

22 (A) by designating the matter beginning  
23 with “The State” as clause (ii); and

24 (B) by striking “(A)” and inserting the  
25 following:

1           “(A)(i) The individual presents a document  
2           described in subparagraph (B) or (D) of section  
3           1902(x)(3) that establishes the identity of the  
4           individual.”.

Strike section 341(d).
