Insert, after section 112, the following new section
(and conform the table of contents in section 100(b) ac-
cordingly):

1 **SEC. 112A. DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM TO LOWER FED-**
2 **ERAL HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUMS FOR**
3 **INDIVIDUALS IN WELLNESS PROGRAMS.**

4 (a) **ESTABLISHMENT.**—Each applicable Secretary
5 shall establish a demonstration program to reduce the pre-
6 miums of individuals enrolled in any qualified Federal
7 health insurance program administered by such Secretary
8 if such individuals meaningfully participate (as determined
9 by such Secretary) in a qualified wellness program

10 (b) **DEFINITIONS.**—For purposes of this subsection:

11 (1) **APPLICABLE SECRETARY.**—The term “ap-
12 plicable Secretary” means—

13 (A) with respect to Medicaid, Medicare,
14 and the Public Health Insurance Option, the
15 Secretary of Health and Human Services;

16 (B) with respect to Tricare, the Secretary
17 of Defense;

1 (C) with respect to health care under sec-
2 tion 5 of the Peace Corps Act (22 U.S.C.
3 2504), the Director of the Peace Corps;

4 (D) with respect to the Federal employees
5 health benefit program under chapter 18 of title
6 5, United States Code, the Office of Personnel
7 Management; and

8 (E) with respect to any other Federal
9 health program that charges a premium to en-
10 rollees, the head of the agency or department
11 that administers such program.

12 (2) QUALIFIED FEDERAL HEALTH INSURANCE
13 PROGRAM.—The term “qualified Federal health in-
14 surance program” means any Federal health insur-
15 ance program that charges a premium to enrollees,
16 including—

17 (A) the Medicaid program under title XIX
18 of the Social Security Act;

19 (B) the Medicare program under title
20 XVIII of the Social Security Act;

21 (C) the Public Health Insurance Option
22 under subtitle B of title III of this division;

23 (D) the Tricare program under chapter 55
24 of title 10, United States Code;

1 (E) health care under section 5 of the
2 Peace Corps Act (22 U.S.C. 2504); and

3 (F) the Federal employees health benefit
4 program under chapter 18 of title 5, United
5 States Code.

6 (3) QUALIFIED WELLNESS PROGRAM.—The
7 term “qualified wellness program” shall have the
8 meaning given such term in section 112(b).
